Now that the final phase of our major renovation project is completed, I am taking this opportunity to personally thank you for a job well done by the **TRIDOME** team.



Again, thank you, gentlemen, for your excellent work and support. Hopefully, we can work together again in the near future.



We have now occupied our new fitness premises since last December and would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the critical and key role you have played as a member of the total construction team.

The renovations tender process was a most arduous one due to numerous budget cuts that were necessary. Throughout these initial two month series of three separate tenders, Tridome continued to display a professional and an aggressive pricing approach showing comprehension of the complex task ahead.

As we lost significant time due to numerous budget revisions, we were forced to make it up in the construction schedule. This has put a tremendous pressure on Tridome to perform overtime and double shifts and week-end work which you did as required. This work was further complicated by the fact that we as the client have pledged to stay open and maintain full activities of the "Y" from 6:00 a.m. - 11:00 p.m. six days of the week. Through your collaboration we were able to continue to serve our members in critical areas such as the large and small gymnasiums, the locker room, showers and health clubs.

Although there were numerous changes (over 100 were requested by the "Y") due to the complex nature of the renovations, to your credit, Tridome never took advantage of the situation. Of course the project was not simple and many times not only additional construction but also extra management effort was required.

We will have other projects in the near future and would seriously consider Tridome again as the general contractor for our Association.
